





PHONICS

- Letters and Sounds Contains games and activities we use to help children with phonics.
 Available online for FREE.
- Children are taught to read by breaking down words into separate sounds or 'phonemes'. They are then taught how to blend these sounds together to read the whole word.
- Children have a 20 minute daily phonics lesson every morning.
- Children will be assessed each half term using past phonics papers. In Summer term there will be a Phonics screening test.



HOW CAN YOU HELP?



Children can also practise their phonics by playing games online.
