# RIGHTS RESPECTING



**Article 14:** (freedom of thought, belief and religion) Every child has the right to think and believe what they choose and also to practise their religion, as long as they are not stopping other people from enjoying their rights. Governments must respect the rights and responsibilities of parents to guide. their child as they grow up.

<u>Online</u> <u>Safety</u> - <u>Bullying</u> <u>Online</u>: During anti-bullying week some children discussed the question- 'Is banter ever an excuse for bullying? 1.Online chatrooms and message boards are another place where bullying is disguised as banter.

2.Some feel free to make comments either about a person in the chat room or outside. The intention is to make others laugh, but the harmful effects on the person being written about are not considered. Often these comments do not remain online and the victim is made aware by those who have seen the comments.

Some games let players turn off communications features, mute voice chat and report other players who behave inappropriately. Look at the settings available to see what's best for your child. Please monitor your child's use of these apps, and discuss the impact of unkind posts and messages, so they are ready to use social media in a respectful manner at an appropriate age.
