**Rights Respecting- Raising Awareness on children's rights**

## RIGHTS RESPECTING



**Article 12** (respect for the views of the child) Every child has the right to express their views, feelings and wishes in all matters affecting them, and to have their views considered and taken seriously. This right applies at all times, for example during immigration proceedings, housing decisions or the child's day-to-day home life.

**Reception School Applications for September 2023:** All parents/carers of children in the Nursery are required to submit their child's application for Primary School by **Sunday 15th January 2023**. Parents/carers are required to submit three supporting documents as proof of residency along with the application. **Online Safety - Bullying Online:** Last week was anti-bullying week and the children discussed the question - **Is banter ever an excuse for bullying?** Online chatrooms and message boards are another place where bullying is disguised as banter. Some feel free to make comments either about a person in the chat room or outside. The intention is to make others laugh, but the harmful effects on the person being written about are not considered. Often these comments do not remain online and the victim is made aware by those who have seen the comments.

Some games let players turn off communications features, mute voice chat and report other players who behave inappropriately. Look at the settings available to see what's best for your child. Please monitor your child's use of these apps, and discuss the impact of unkind posts and messages, so they are ready to use social media in a respectful manner at an appropriate age.
